SPRING POOL PREP

As temperatures rise, algae pressure increases.

Tip:

- Increase pump run time to 8-10 hours daily
- Make sure timers reflect daylight savings changes
- Variable-speed pumps may need seasonal RPM adjustments

☛ Warmer water = faster chlorine consumption.

Skimmer & Basket Maintenance

Wind and pollen season are coming.

Homeowners can:

- Empty skimmer baskets between service visits if full
- Clear debris from pool surface after heavy wind
- Keep surrounding landscaping trimmed

This prevents suction blockages and pump strain.

Check for Leaks & Prime Loss

Spring expansion can expose plumbing issues.

Tell your technician if you notice any of the following:

- Air bubbles in returns
- Pump losing prime
- Wet spots near equipment
- Water level dropping more than ¼" per day

Early leak detection prevents major repairs.

SPRING WATER TREATMENT SCHEDULE

As we move into warmer months, we will begin our seasonal preventative treatments:

March - Clarify Treatment

This treatment helps:

- Eliminate early algae growth
- Boost water clarity
- Stabilize sanitizer efficiency before peak season

April - Phosphate Treatment

Phosphates feed algae. Even clear pools can have high phosphate levels.

Our phosphate treatment:

- Reduces algae food sources
- Improves chlorine efficiency
- Helps prevent green water during heat spikes
